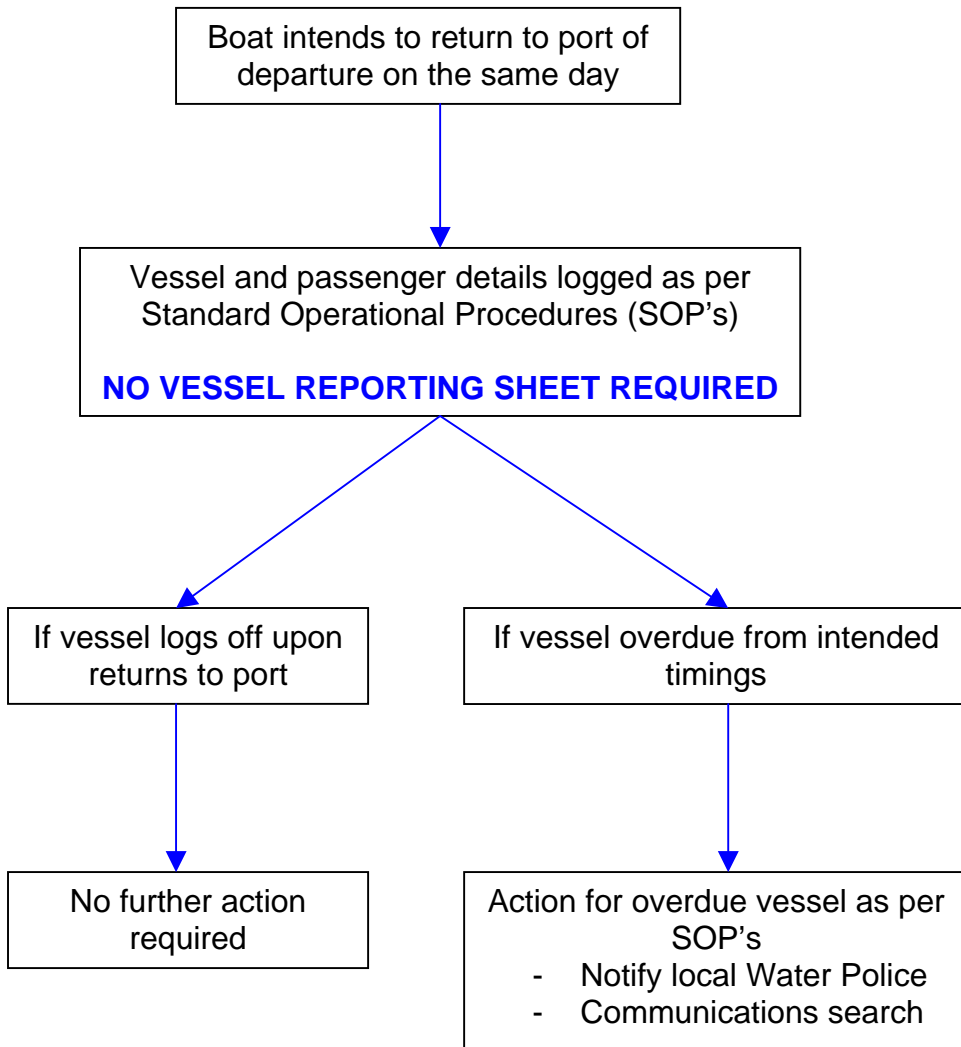

Copies of this comments page from each unit should be forwarded at the end of each month (nil return will also be required) to the State Manager of your Association.

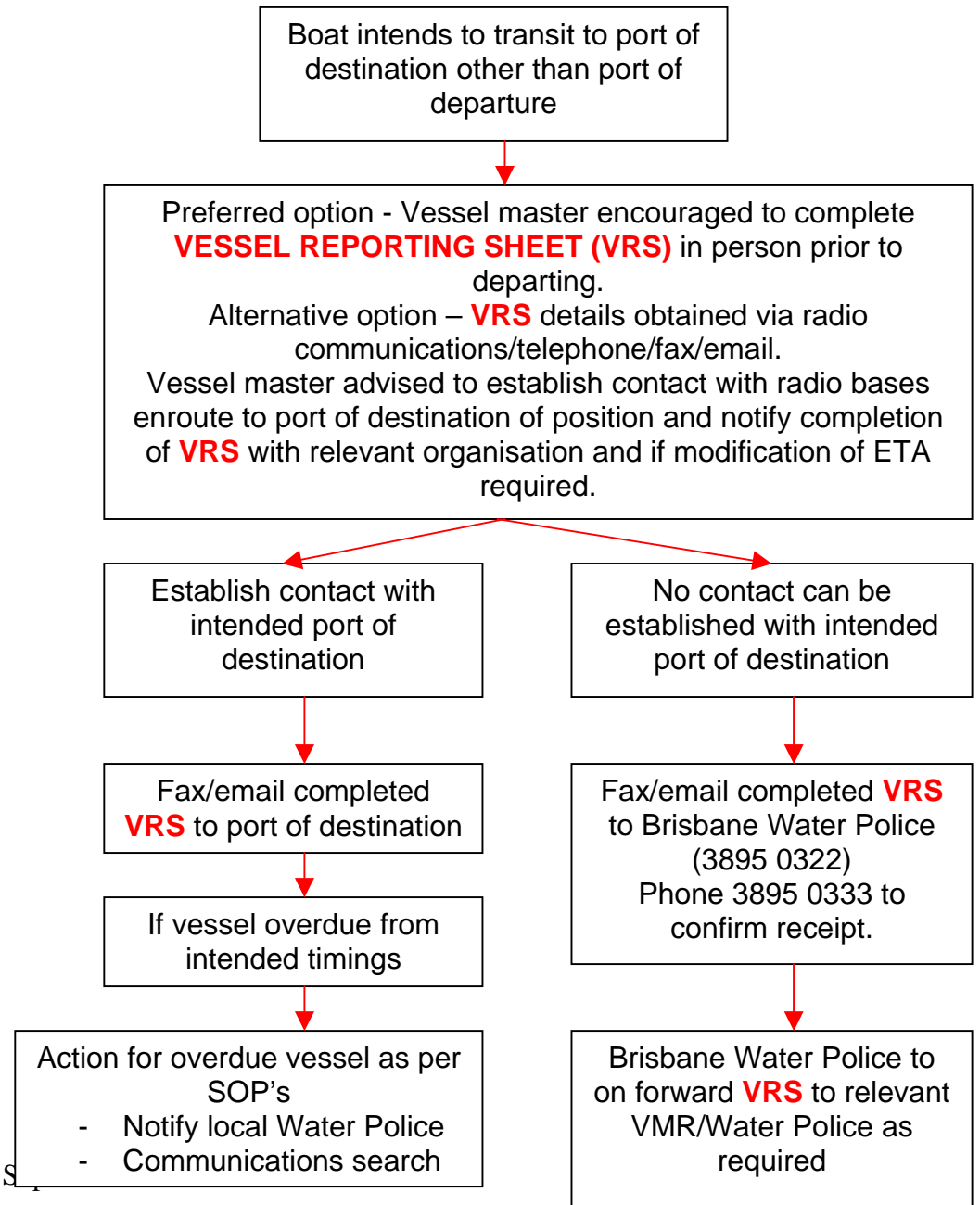
